The objective of this program is to:

Educate

You may utilise the Envirobank plasma screens to educate your students on recycling and the environment.

Reward

Rewarding your school for recycling efforts by paying you for the material collected. Funds are paid directly to your school and can be utilised at your schools discretion.

Reduce

The Envirobank units will assist your school in reducing waste, waste disposal costs, recycle efficiently and reduce your environmental footprint. Your school will be provided with a quartley Environmental Savings Report.

Incentives will encourage students to use the machine with competitions. While the **community** and **students** benefit, because Envirobank will be the communication partner for Kids Helpline, and will display information about them on the plasma screens from time to time.

FAQ

What are the benefits of using Envirobank's Reverse Vending Machines?

Firstly Reverse Vending has existed for 32 years so this is not a new concept worldwide, it's just new to the Australian market place. Envirobank units can compact plastic at 4:1 and crush aluminum at 13:1 significantly reducing the amount of collections therefore reducing carbon emissions created by transportation. We offer the users a way of recycling sensibly.

What are the *rewards*?

Envirobank is offering each school a \$500 prize fund for every 50,000 aluminum/pet/hdpe* containers recycled.

\$1000 prize fund for 100,000 containers or more.

The school is able to spend these funds at their own discretion.

Our school has 500 students how many containers per student do we collect each week?

Two containers a day would easily meet the 50,000 target. That's their morning tea juice bottle, and lunchtime water bottle.

What type of containers can we recycle?

These machines can be programmed to accept and compact a wide variety of beverage containers allowing for

the quick and clean retrieval of approx 99% of containers on the market place today.

What types of incentives are available for our *students*?

Our machines print a voucher which shows you how many containers you have recycled. Each container equals one point.

These vouchers can be used as entry forms for a monthly prize draw. (prizes are supplied by Envirobank)

How will we know how many containers we have recycled?

These machines are very intelligent and can recognize each container by material and count what has been recycled and rejects foreign objects e.g. Tin cans, Steel cans. You get a monthly print out of the containers you have recycled.

What does it the cost the school?

Only \$500!!*
